

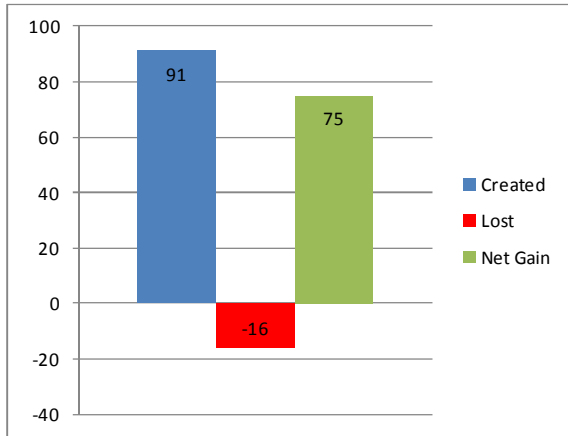


Workforce Planning Board Monthly Labour Force Survey Employment Stats Covering the Month of May 2011

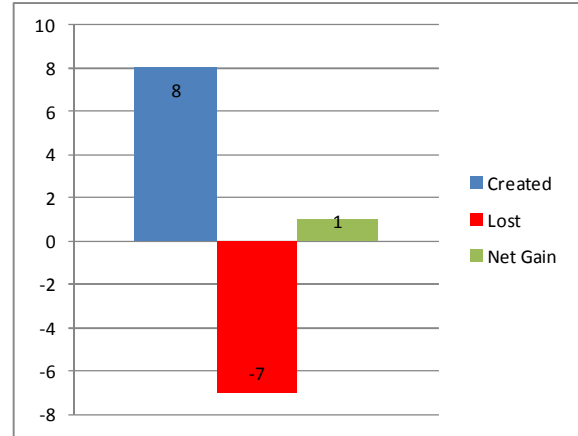
Here are highlights from the survey conducted in June 2011 covering the month of May 2011.

Overall Jobs Gained/Lost



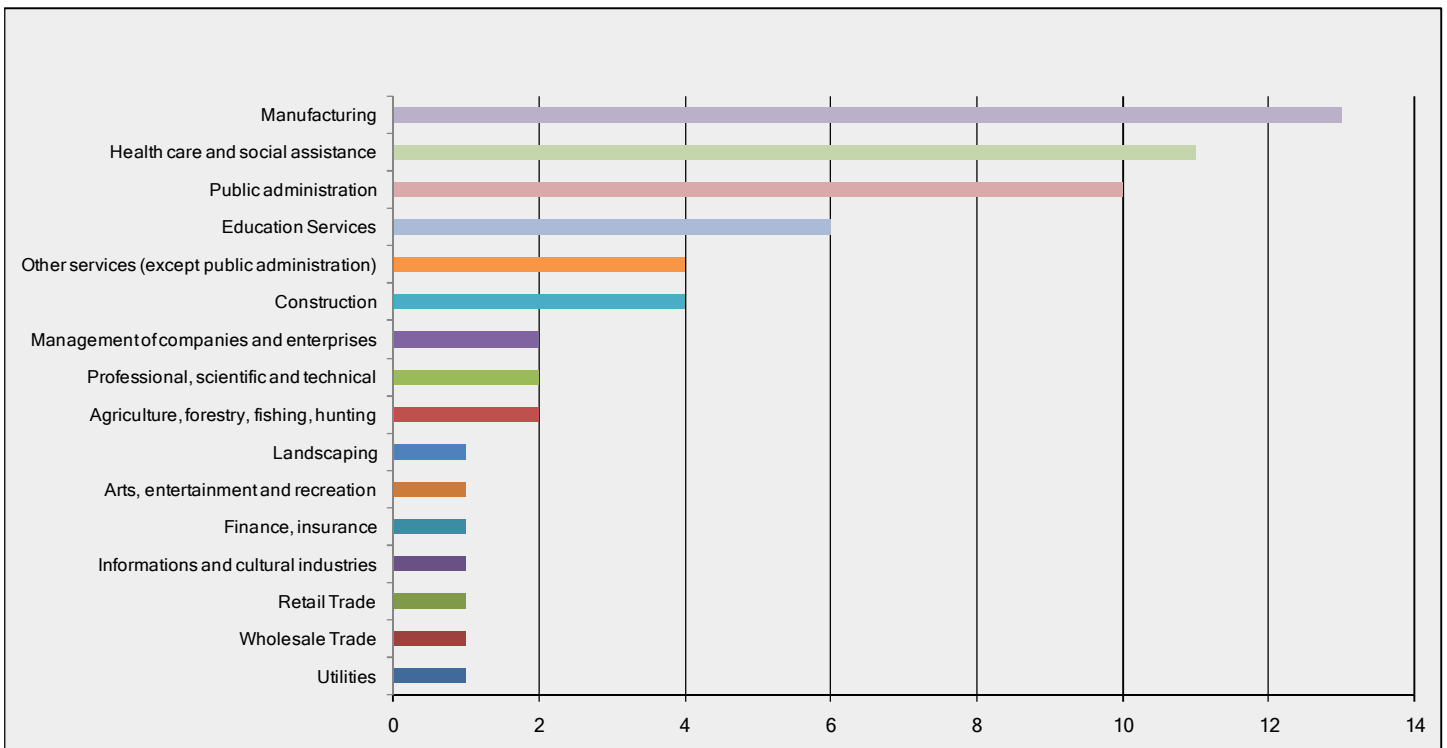
The total number of jobs created, both full and part-time, was 91 while the number of jobs lost was 16 for a net gain of 75.

Manufacturing Jobs Gained/Lost

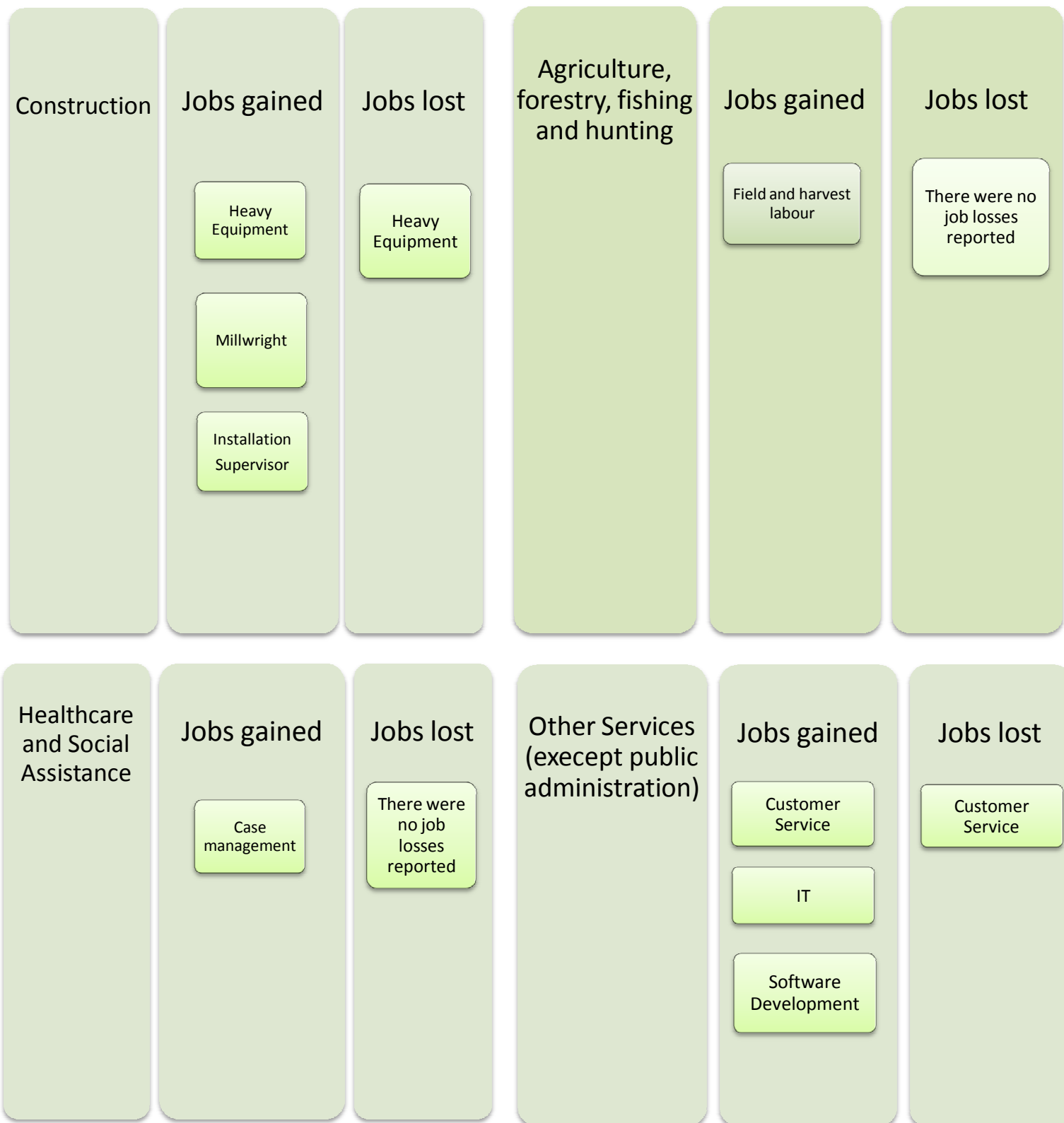


The number of manufacturing jobs created, both full and part-time, was 8 while the number of jobs lost was 7 for a net gain of 1.

The following charts show a sample of the types of occupations added or lost during the month of May by the top 4 sectors. Construction (ICI and Residential) had the largest increase of 28 positions. Other Services (except public administration) reported the largest loss of 5 positions:
