

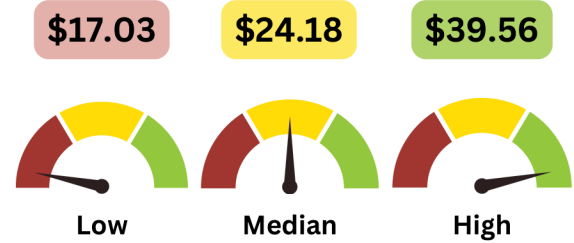

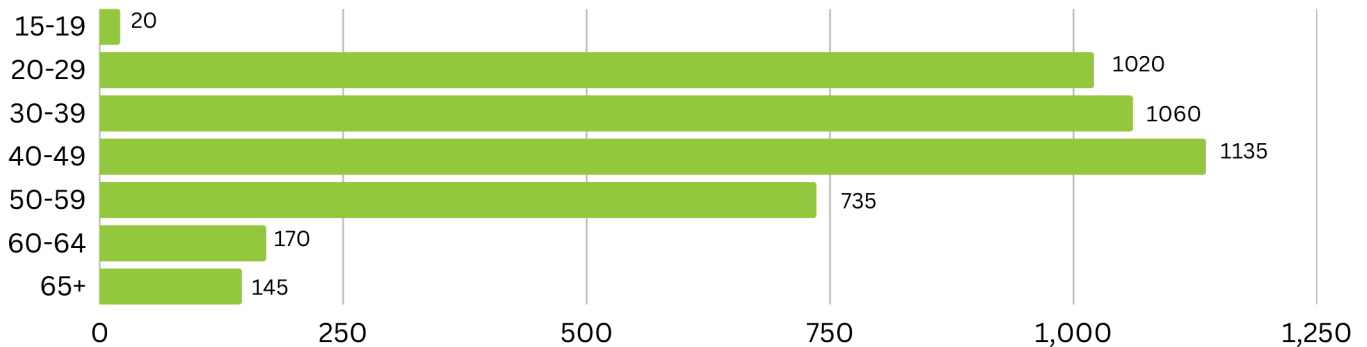


Who are the people in this occupation?

Job Searchers & Apprenticeship
