

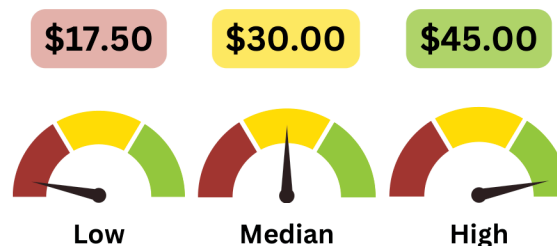

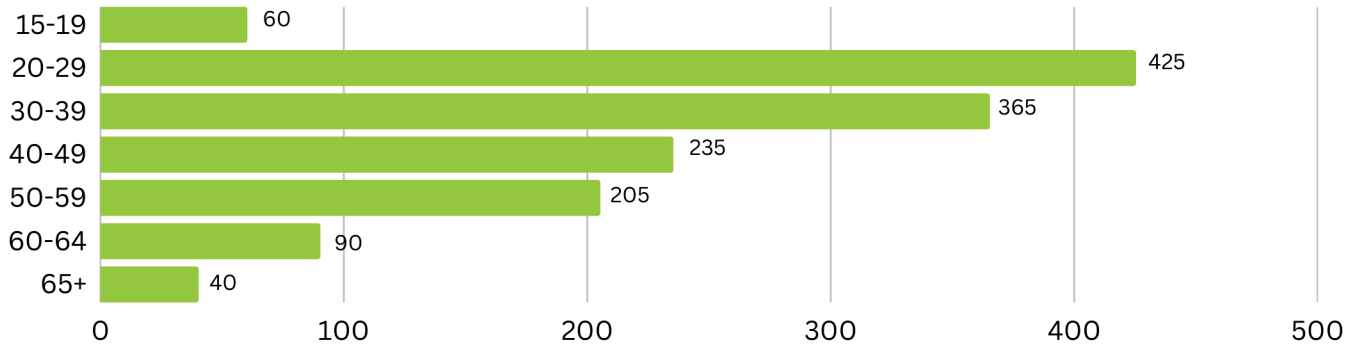


Who are the people in this occupation?
